



**NC Pre-K Eligibility Criteria
2022-2023 School Year**

The NC Pre-K program provides high-quality educational experiences to help eligible four-year-olds get ready for Kindergarten.

You can apply if your child will be 4 years old by August 31, 2022, and one (or more) of the following applies:

- Your family meets the income criteria for the program as follows:
