



EARN MORE MONEY TO REWARD YOUR EDUCATION AND COMMITMENT TO EARLY CHILDHOOD

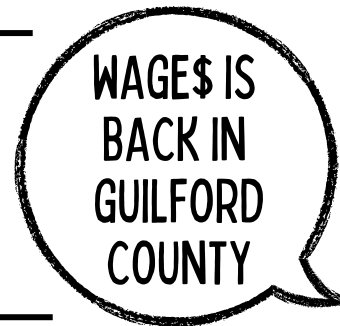
The Child Care WAGE\$ Program provides education-based salary supplements (eligible every six months) to individuals working with children birth to five. **The program is designed to increase retention, education and compensation.**

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR WAGE\$, APPLICANTS MUST:

- Work in a licensed childcare program (center, home, public school, or Head Start site)
- **Earn at or below \$19 hourly (updated September 2022)**
- Have an education level listed on the WAGE\$ scale (see back of flyer)
- Work at least six months in the **same childcare program**
- Be employed at this same childcare program when funding is available and when a final employment confirmation has been completed

EDUCATION LEVELS USED TO DETERMINE WAGES\$ SUPPLEMENT

9	Doctorate Degree plus or including at least 6 B-5 hours OR Master's Degree plus or including at least 6 B-5 hours OR Bachelor's Degree plus or including at least 6 B-5 hours	\$1,875
8	Associate Degree plus or including at least 24 B-5 hours OR Doctorate, Master's, or Bachelor's Degree (less than 6 B-5 hours)	\$1,500
7	Associate Degree plus or including at least 18 B-5 hours OR 57 hours of general education including at least 24 B-5 hours	\$1,325
6	Associate Degree plus or including at least 12 B-5 hours OR 45 hours of general education including at least 18 B-5 hours	\$1,125
5	Associate Degree including at least 6 B-5 hours OR 70 semester hours of general education including at least 6 B-5 hours	\$950
4	36 hours of general education including at least 12 B-5 hours OR Associate Degree (less than 6 hours) OR 70 semester hours of general education (less than 6 B-5 hours)	\$750
3	24 hours of general education including at least 6 B-5 hours	\$600
2	18 hours of general education including at least 4 B-5 hours OR Early Childhood Certificate OR CDA Credential (Child Development Associate Credential) earned for at least 12 semester hours OR 12 birth to five focused semester hours	\$450
1	6 Birth to five focused semester hours OR Completion of NC Early Childhood Credential Coursework OR Completion of NC Family Child Care Credential Coursework (for family child care only)	N/A
